



PATIENT CARE

The Foundation supports Lexington Medical Center's mission by enhancing hospital services and providing hope through patient and community programs. These services and programs affect every area of patient care in Lexington Medical Center's network of care.

- **AED CABINETS** •

Automatic external defibrillator cabinets and supplies to assist medical staff during crises.

- **BABY DOLL THERAPY** •

Baby dolls and stuffed animals for patients with dementia or Alzheimer's disease.

- **BLOOD SUGAR TESTING SUPPLIES** •

Educational materials and supplies for newly-diagnosed or uncontrolled diabetic patients to assist with monitoring blood sugar levels at home.

- **CLOTHING FOR EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT PATIENTS** •

Clothing for patients being discharged who do not have appropriate attire.

- **COGNITIVE HOSPITALITY CART** •

Small items to promote improved concentration and decrease delirium for Intensive Care Unit patients.

- **COMMUNITY OUTREACH AND PROJECT PRESCRIPTION** •

Medication and transportation vouchers for uninsured and underinsured patients.

• **COMPLEX CARE PATIENT SUPPLIES** •

Provides essential supplies to Emergency department patients during visits.

• **DIABETES EDUCATION** •

Educational and motivational materials focused on diabetes for underserved rural populations.

• **DIABETIC SUPPLIES** •

Essential diabetic supplies for newly diagnosed diabetic patients in the hospital and physician practices in Batesburg-Leesville and Swansea.

• **EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT HOSPITALITY CART** •

Emergency department program that provides essentials for patients during visits.

• **EXERCISE IS MEDICINE** •

Exercise equipment, classes and specialized training for patients with chronic health conditions such as cancer or diabetes.

• **EXTENDED CARE RESIDENT HOSPITALITY CART** •

Small items for Extended Care patients to assist with daily activities.

• **HEALTHSTREAM MYCLINICAL EXCHANGE PLATFORM** •

Electronic platform for scheduling and onboarding nursing students.

• **HOME BLOOD PRESSURE MONITORING** •

Tools for at-home blood pressure monitoring provided to patients with hypertension.

• **HOSPITAL TO HOME PROGRAM** •

Non-medical in-home care for high-risk patients following discharge from the hospital.

• **INPATIENT PAPR STORAGE BAGS** •

Powered air purifying respirator (PAPR) hood storage bags for health care workers caring for COVID-19 patients.

• **INTERACTIVE ENGAGEMENT SYSTEMS** •

Interactive computer system for that assists Extended Care residents with rehabilitation therapy.

• **MEDICATION BOXES** •

Pill boxes for high-risk patients.

• **STOP THE BLEED CLASSES AND TOURNIQUETS** •

Stop the Bleed classes for Lexington Medical Center employees and volunteers, and Stop the Bleed classes and tourniquets provided to community members.

• **SUPEREAR®** •

Devices offered to patients with hearing difficulty while at the hospital to ensure proper communication.

• **TOTAL JOINT PROGRAM** •

Tote bags for Total Joint Program participants.

• **VEIN FINDER** •

Device that assists health care workers in placing IVs.

• **WHITE NOISE MACHINES** •

Noise machines for patient rooms to promote better sleep.
