Lexington Medical Center fights cancer alongside its patients. The Foundation supports this care philosophy with cancer programs that help patients focus on their treatment and survivorship. These hospital- and community-based programs ensure patients can meet their basic needs, including access to critical medications and financial assistance with living expenses.

• 3-D MAMMOGRAPHY •

Doctors recommend 3-D mammography for women having their first screening mammograms and those who have dense breast tissue. Through the Foundation's "Campaign for Clarity," a three-year, \$3 million capital campaign, this important screening and diagnostic technology will be available at all imaging facilities in Lexington Medical Center's network of care.

• BECKY'S PLACE BOUTIQUE •

As the Midlands only appearance and

resource center, Becky's Place offers wigs, mastectomy bras and prosthetics to patients undergoing cancer treatment and those who have completed it.

• CANCER CARE FUND •

The Cancer Care Fund provides in-need patients with financial assistance to purchase medications and pay for utilities and basic living expenses while they undergo treatment. The fund also supports continuing education and certification for Lexington Medical Center employees.

• CRYSTAL SMITH BREAST CANCER FUND •

Through the Crystal Smith Breast Cancer Fund, the Foundation provides breast cancer patients with wigs, mastectomy bras and post-surgical kits.

• WELLNESS WORKOUTS •

Individualized sessions with a specialized trainer help cancer patients cope with the side effects of treatment.

• NUTRITION IS MEDICINE PROGRAM •

This course educates cancer patients about healthier eating habits to support their battle against cancer.

• LINDA'S LOVE FUND •

The Lexington Medical Center Foundation offers uninsured and under-insured women access to 3-D mammography for diagnostic exams through Linda's Love Fund.
