• HALO® SLEEPSACKS® •

The use of infant sleep sacks is one way to reduce the risk of sudden infant death syndrome. Not only does the Foundation supply HALO SleepSacks for the hospital's Mother/Baby department, it also provides free swaddles for all new parents to help protect their infant from SIDS at home.

• INFANT CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION KITS •

The Lexington Medical Center Foundation supplies infant cardiopulmonary resuscitation kits to all families bringing babies home from the hospital's Special Care Nursery. These kits teach lifesaving skills to new parents, grandparents and other caregivers.

• DOULA PROGRAM •

The Foundation funds the training, certification and availability of doulas. At Lexington Medical Center, doulas provide continuous physical, emotional and informational support to mothers during childbirth. This service is free to all expectant families at the hospital.

• NEWBORN BABY SUPPLIES •

The Foundation provides essential newborn baby supplies to families who cannot afford these items.

• PERINATAL LOSS PROGRAM •

Supported by the Lexington Medical Center Foundation, this unique program educates staff caring for families who have suffered a newborn loss, providing families with guidance and resources during this difficult time.
